Elementary Activities	Club Participation Fee	Variable – Other clubs may be added during the 2020-21 school year. Fees associated with those clubs will be provided at that time.	To cover a portion of the cost of operating the individual club	Student may be restricted from participation in club or certain club activities
Elementary Activities	Make with Minette	Variable projects not to exceed \$10 per session.	To cover a portion of the cost of materials for the project.	Student may be restricted from participation in club or certain club activities
Elementary Activities	Enrichment Participation Fee	Variable – Fees associated with those enrichments will be provided at that time.	To cover a portion of the cost of operating the individual program	Student cannot participate in enrichment/extension program
Classroom Fee	Consumable material	\$35 per year	To cover actual cost of consumable material used by the student in the classroom and/or are items students will retain after the class. Examples includes readers, t-shirts, workbooks, communication folders, planners, party supplies, etc.	Required items/materials or a comparable alternative will be provided. Students will not be excluded from classroom activities if the fee is unpaid
School Fee (optional)	Yearbook	\$60 per year book (not required)	To cover a portion of the cost of producing and printing a yearbook.	Student will not receive a yearbook.

Middle School Activities	NJHS	\$20 per year	To cover a portion of the cost of operating the individual activity, pin, award, and induction ceremony	Student may be restricted from participation in club or certain club activities
Middle School Activities	Sports Clinics/Modules	Variable - Fees associated with those clinics/modules will be provided at that time.	To cover a portion of the cost of operating the individual activity.	Student may be restricted from participation in club or certain club activities
Classroom Fee	Core Academic Consumable material fee	\$30 per year if applicable	To cover actual cost of consumable material used by the student in the classroom and/or are items students will retain after the class.	Required items/materials or a comparable alternative will be provided.
Course Fee	Field Trip Fee	Varies by field trip/excursion – See school communication	To cover cost or a portion of the cost of admission and transportation, if applicable. Fee is relative to cost of field trip/excursion.	With prior arrangement, a student who desires to participate in class field trip/excursion will not be excluded if the fee is unpaid
School Fee (optional)	Yearbook	\$60 per year book- not required	To cover a portion of the cost of producing and printing a yearbook.	Student will not receive a yearbook.
Tuition	Sixth Grade High Trails (4 days)	\$285 per session	To cover a portion of the cost of the 6th grade outdoor high trails experience. Cost covers curriculum, supervision, transportation, lodging, and food	Payment of fee is required for participation. Students who do not participate in the program will be offered a comparable alternative at reduced or no cost
User Fee	District issued personal mobile technology device	\$50 per school year	To offset a portion of the cost of devices and to insure against theft, damage, and loss	Student will not be issued a personal mobile technology device
